Dear Ms. Warr:

Pursuant to NRS (Nevada Revised Statutes) 239 et seq., I write to request a copy of all applications for registration as a prostitute filed with the Lyon County Sheriff for the last 10 years pursuant to Lyon County Code 5.03.14. Please include all information on the application, including the address of the prostitute and all addresses of the prostitute for the preceding three (3) years. If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address.

I agree to pay any actual cost (as defined in NRS 239) to your office for providing copies of the requested applications not more than \$45. If the cost would be greater than this amount, please notify me. Please provide a receipt indicating the charges for each document.

As provided by the open records law, I will expect your response with five (5) business days. If a copy of the records I am requesting will take longer than five business days, please contact me with a date and time after which I will receive a copy of the records. If I do not receive a copy of the records by that date and time, I may inquire regarding the status of the request pursuant to NRS 239.0107.

If you choose to deny any or all of this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. Also, please provide all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material.

Violation of the Open Records Act may result in the award of court costs and attorney fees pursuant to NRS 239.011. Furthermore, intentional concealment of a public record is a category C felony, punishable by up to 5 years in prison, a fine of up to \$10,000, or both per NRS 239.320.
